




- **REINVESTING**
\$261.9 million into Los Angeles County communities, through lending (\$70.5 million), real estate (\$13.77 million) and neighborhood revitalization activities, preserving more than \$140.4 million in property values.



- **EDUCATING**
2,597 families regarding homeownership purchase, budgeting, credit repair, home maintenance, and insurance services.



- **FACILITATING**
1,281 families to preserve their homes and prevent foreclosure through aggressive mortgage assistance and post purchase education fairs, clinics, and workshops, affordable lending, loan modifications, and other NHS programs.



- **ASSISTING**
306 families to purchase and 40 families to rehabilitate their properties.



- **COORDINATING**
over 725 volunteers thru 4 Neighborhood Pride Days, and 49 community workshops providing over 7,250 service hours.



- Successfully **COMPLETING**
433 site visits, 61 home inspections, 39 work write ups, 31 job starts and 43 notices of completion on projects.



- **REPRESENTING**
58 buyers, closed on 29 properties, impacting \$8.36 million in real estate. The average listing was on the market 165 days and supported NHS through \$320,000 in commissions.
